Documentation Procedure

- 1. Document initial call. Refer to procedure P-192.615.
- 2. Document calls to fire, police and governmental agencies.
- 3. After the emergency is complete, review the procedures used to determine their effectiveness. Let DOT Coordinator know of procedural changes that need to be made.
- 4. Place original in File 192.615. Retain Records for 3 years.
- 5. Refer to Procedure P-191.5 to determine if this emergency constitutes a reportable accident or P-191.23 to determine if it is a safety-related condition. If so complete F-191.1 or F-191.25 respectively.
